

Homework for the Easter Holidays:

At pre-school we work on preparing your child for school. We work closely with local schools and have provided a list below of skills they expect children to master before they start school. Even if your child does not start school in September, you may find the list useful. Many of the skills can be acquired in a fun way through games and conversation.

- ✓ Put on and remove shoes (please send your child in velcro or slip on shoes to support this at pre-school)
- ✓ Independently put on and take off clothes e.g. coat, trousers, t-shirt, socks)
- ✓ Listening to and following adult instruction (good looking, good listening, good sitting)
- ✓ Independence in self-care e.g.. Washing hands and blowing nose themselves
- ✓ Fully toilet trained and can independently wipe themselves after using the toilet
- ✓ Beginning to write letters from name/ writing full name /able to recognise their name.
- ✓ Phonics skills- practicing letter sounds/recognising letters
- ✓ Number skills (number recognition 1-10, counting 1-20 10-0, simple sums such as one more/ one less than a given number)
